Requirements

Skaters should have passed Learn to Skate in **Step 1: Beginners**. To ensure skaters are familiar with skating in hockey skates/equipment, it is suggested to enroll them in **Step 2: Introduction to Ice Sports - Pre Hockey**. Participants should be able to fully function by themselves on the ice in hockey skates and pads, fall down and get up on their own, push off with both feet, take a full stride and have some stopping and backward skating ability before getting into **FUNDamentals**. If you're not sure if your child is ready for Bruins **FUNDamentals**, be sure to talk to your Learn to Skate instructor, your local **FUNDamentals** coach or call the FMC Ice Sports hockey department at 1-888-74-SKATE.



Level 1

This class is designed for participants just out of a Learn to Skate and/or Pre Hockey program. We will take them from their first hockey experience to a point where they can begin learning **FUNDamental** hockey-specific skills. While players are on the ice in full equipment, the primary focus will be on further developing and strengthening their skating skills in a fun atmosphere.

Key Objectives: Introduce proper stance • Improve balance and agility
Enhance starting, stopping, gliding and striding skills • Forward, backward and lateral skating/movement • Introduce basic puck handling

Level 2

In this class, participants will begin learning key hockey-specific skills that are needed before game play is introduced. Players will further develop their skating ability, as puck control, shooting and passing are introduced at this level.

Key Objectives: Teach forehand and backhand passing • Introduce edge control, cross-overs and pivoting
Teach forward and backward hockey starts and stops • Develop skating and puck carrying skills
Introduce basic shooting and scoring

Level 3

Once a skater has developed a strong skating base and learned the basic skills needed to participate in the sport of hockey, it is time to introduce them to the game. Level 3 is geared towards teaching the basic knowledge and rules of hockey, along with developing teamwork; important skills needed to enter into an organized hockey program.

Key Objectives: Introduce basic positioning • Develop a fundamental understanding of the rules
Learn basic teamwork and strategy • Understanding offensive and defensive concepts • Exposure to the various positions on the ice

Level 4: Late Starters

This program is specifically targeted for skaters aged 9-12 who are new to the sport of ice hockey. Participants will go through the progression of skill development in a program that is tailored to their abilities in a group setting. Skills that will be addressed are puck handling, passing and shooting, as well as the strengthening of skating ability. This program can be taken for multiple consecutive sessions in order to get a player prepared to enter organized youth hockey.
