Eligibility Rules & Requirements

EVENTS

PreAlpha, Alpha, Beta, Gamma, Delta, Freestyle, Open Freestyle, Spotlight, Special Skater, Artistic, Couples, Footwork, Interpretive, Jump & Spin, Dance, Solo Compulsories, Synchronized Skating, Synchronized Compulsories, Synchronized Formation, Production, Ensemble, Team Compulsories. (Refer to current ISI publications)

Age groupings will be adjusted to suit enrollment.

RULES

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines set forth in the most recent edition of the ISI Handbook along with the 2012 Rule Revisions.

VERIFICATION

The team coach must sign the entry form to verify that the information contained on the form is true and correct. The information must be accurate and complete. Inaccurate or incomplete forms will be returned.

ELIGIBILITY

All skaters entering the competition must be current individual members of an administrative member rink and registered at their highest test level with ISI. Skaters may not enter an event at a higher or lower level than their last test passed and registered by the deadline date. Coaches may compete at this competition. If a Professional competes in an individual event, they will not be eligible to judge at this competition, but the Professional may compete in team events and still be eligible to act as a judge in other events.

Members of USFS, who are individual members and registered with the ISI are eligible to compete in accordance with the ISI/USFS Joint Statement of Policy. Skaters are expected to compete at their true ability level and to uphold high ethical standards.

AWARDS

Team events for Production, Team Compulsories and Synchronized teams will receive 25 points for 1st Place; 20 points for 2nd Place; 15 points for 3rd Place; 10 points for 4th Place; and 5 points for 5th Place. In addition, each team entry in these events will receive 5 participation points. All other events will receive 5 points for 1st Place; 4 points for 2nd Place; 3 points for 3rd Place; 2 points for 4th Place; and 1 point for 5th Place. In addition, each competition event entry will receive 1 participation point. Individual awards will be given for the first five places in each event. The team (club) accumulating the most overall team points will be declared the winner. Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.

TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE

A tentative time schedule is enclosed with this packet. Please post this schedule prominently at your rink, as it will help your skaters plan their weekend.

FEES

Skaters should make their checks payable to their home team and the team coach should send one check payable to FMC ICE SPORTS.

MUSIC, REGISTRATION, AND PHOTOGRAPHS

CDs are required. CD's are to be labeled with the skater's name, team name, event, age group and side to be played. CD's must be handed in at the Registration Desk one hour before event. No more than one program is to be on a CD and please have a duplicate with you at the arena. Photographs and video tapes may be taken for personal use only. They may not be sold, rented or otherwise used for any commercial of profit making business unless authorized in writing by the Competition Director. Photos may be used on the District 1 website.

2012 ISI Test and Competition Rule Revisions (updated 9/12/11)

The following 2012 Synchronized Competitions Revisions are **mandatory for all competitions after September 1, 2011**. Competition Directors should inform all participated and judges before their event.

Synchronized Competition Event Revisions & Clarifications:

- Synchronized Skating Teams in both the Teen and Senior Youth age divisions can now perform any spin(s).
- Synchronized Formation Teams can perform 2-foot spins in any age division.
- Synchronized team skaters are now limited to compete at **one age division lower than their true age division** (for example, a 12 year old Sr. Youth team skaters can skate on a Youth team, but not on a Jr. Youth team). **Skaters can compete in any higher age division category***. All age divisions still require a MAJORITY of skaters- but not every skater to fit within the age division for that team. ***Note- This is a revised change in wording from previous printed versions of these Rule Revisions.**

New Synchronized Events:

NEW! **Synchronized Skating Open Competition Event**: This event is for Sr. Youth, Teen, Collegiate and Adult age divisions only will consist of a 4:00 minute program with no required elements. The program restrictions for traditional skating team events must be followed. The judging criteria will be: Technical Merit, Correctness, Choreography & Pattern, Music Interpretation, Unison, Duration, and General Overall.

NEW! **Advanced Formation Synchronized Event**: The new team category for skaters who are continuing to master the basics of good synchronized skating such as straight lines, correct holds and unison. The program must include at least one of each of the following basic elements: Line, Circle, Block, Wheel and Intersection. Skaters are permitted to skate backwards on one foot but are limited to using only 3-turns and Mohawks for turning and in footwork sequences.

NEW! **Collegiate Age Group for ALL Synchronized Team Events**: The majority of skaters but be ages 18-25, and the team members must be affiliated with the college/university that they are representing.

The following 2012 Test & Competition Revisions are optional for ISI competitions from Sept. 1, 2011 and mandatory for all events after Jan. 1, 2012.

Competition Event Revisions & Clarifications:

Open Freestyle events- Skaters can now perform any spin at any level. The current jump limitations remain in effect for the Bronze, Silver, and Gold levels. The Open Freestyle test maneuver choices remain the same.

Competition Dance Events- As long as the skater had passed the individual ISI dance test, **they can compete that dance in competition events** (i.e. Solo, Similar, Mixed or Pro Partner). The skater is **no longer required to complete all dances** in the higher dance test to compete any dance(s) at that higher level.

Rhythmic Skating Ribbon & Hoop Prop Clarification- The ribbon streamers must be one single streamer piece (not multiple streamers) according to the prop guidelines in the ISI Handbook. The hoop can have colored tape or fabric to match the skaters costume, but it cannot have any other decoration (i.e. fringe, etc.) on the prop. If multiple ribbon streamers or fringe is used on the hoop, those programs should be entered into the Spotlight Light Entertainment category and not in the Rhythmic Skating events.

Judging Revisions & Clarifications:

Solo Compulsory events judging criteria- The "General Overall" criteria will be added to the Judge 1 (Referee) sheet only. Any penalties such as the 2.0 score for attempting illegal maneuvers or taking two attempts at the required maneuvers will be assessed by Judge 1 (Referee).

Open Freestyle events judging criteria-the current "correctness" criteria on the Judge 1 (Referee) sheet will be changed to "Correctness of Jumps". The new criteria for Judge 2 will be "Correctness of Spins." The new criteria for Judge 3 will be "Correctness of Turns and Edges". As a reminder, difficulty of maneuvers is not considered under any Correctness score- only the technical accuracy
